Come join your friends and fellow quilters for a relaxing four day quilters extravaganza in Cincinnati, Ohio; the "New Chicago." Our final destination is the new home to the International Quilt Festival, Cincinnati, OH. I have personally toured and visited our attractions and accommodations as soon as I heard the IQ Festival was going to be held in Cincinnati in 2011, "you will not be disappointed with this new venue." There will be pickups in Greenville, Cedar Springs and the Grand Rapids area.

We will begin our trip with a stop in Waynesville, OH. While in Waynesville, you can enjoy the local quilt store with their huge inventory of quilting material, or take in one of the local antique stores. Waynesville has been dubbed the "Antiques Capital of the Midwest." Our group will be staying the next three nights at Drury Inn - Cincinnati North. After check-in, we'll drive the short five minutes to the downtown Cincinnati convention center and join in on the quilt shows preview night. Day 2 and 3 is yours to explore the expo and attend classes on different quilting techniques, view quilt displays and of course shop! The convention center is located in the heart of a fantastic shopping and restaurant district; all just steps outside the door. Day 3 will also afford you the opportunity to join us on a side trip to the National Underground Freedom Center. The Freedom Center, which is the only Smithsonian Museum not located in Washington, DC, hosts the history of the underground railroad. While we are only 5 minutes away from our hotel, our coach will make periodic trips between the quilt show and our hotel on days 2 and 3, so if you want to go back early or rest for a bit, you'll have a chance to do so. Day 4, we'll check out of the hotel and start heading back towards Michigan. This trip is designed to be relaxing, so if you want to take in classes, you'll have the time to do so. We hope to see you in Cincinnati.
